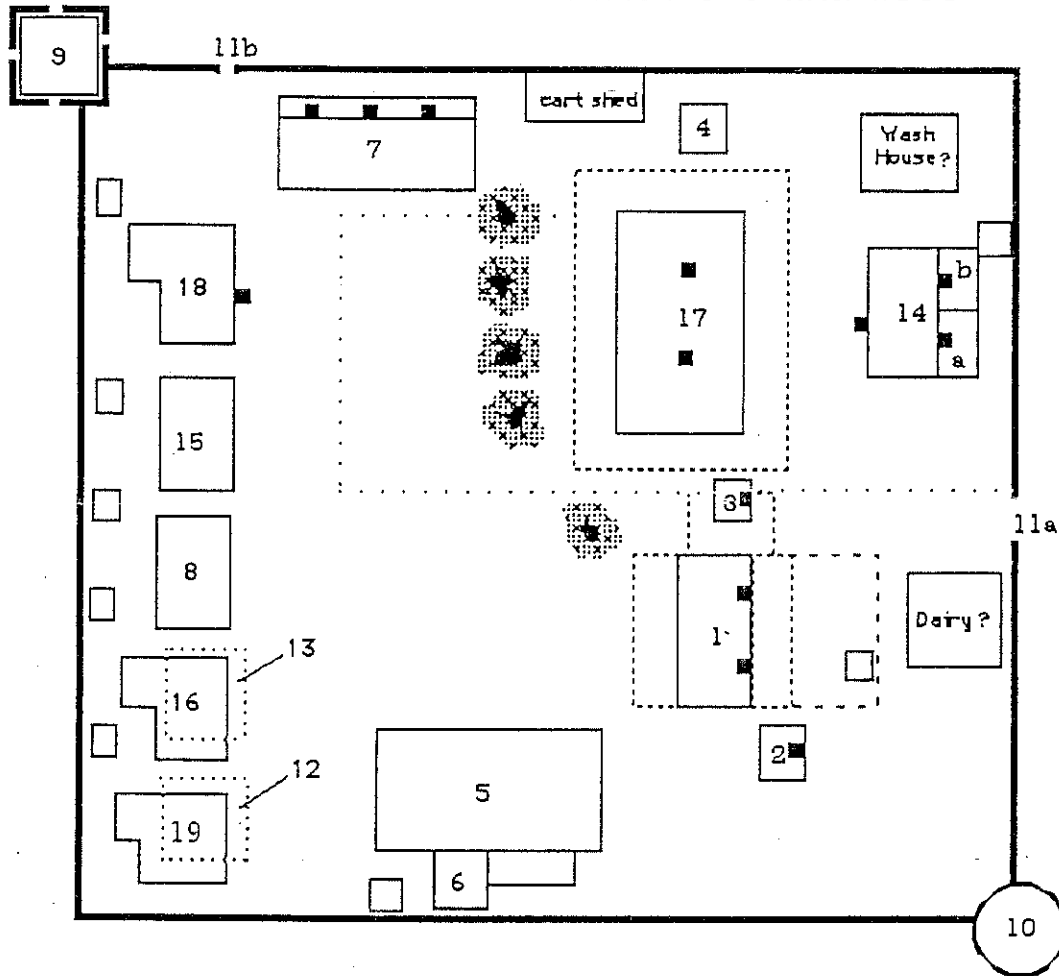


Plate III: Fort Nisqually Developmental Site Plan

Structures That Occurred Between 1843 and 1859

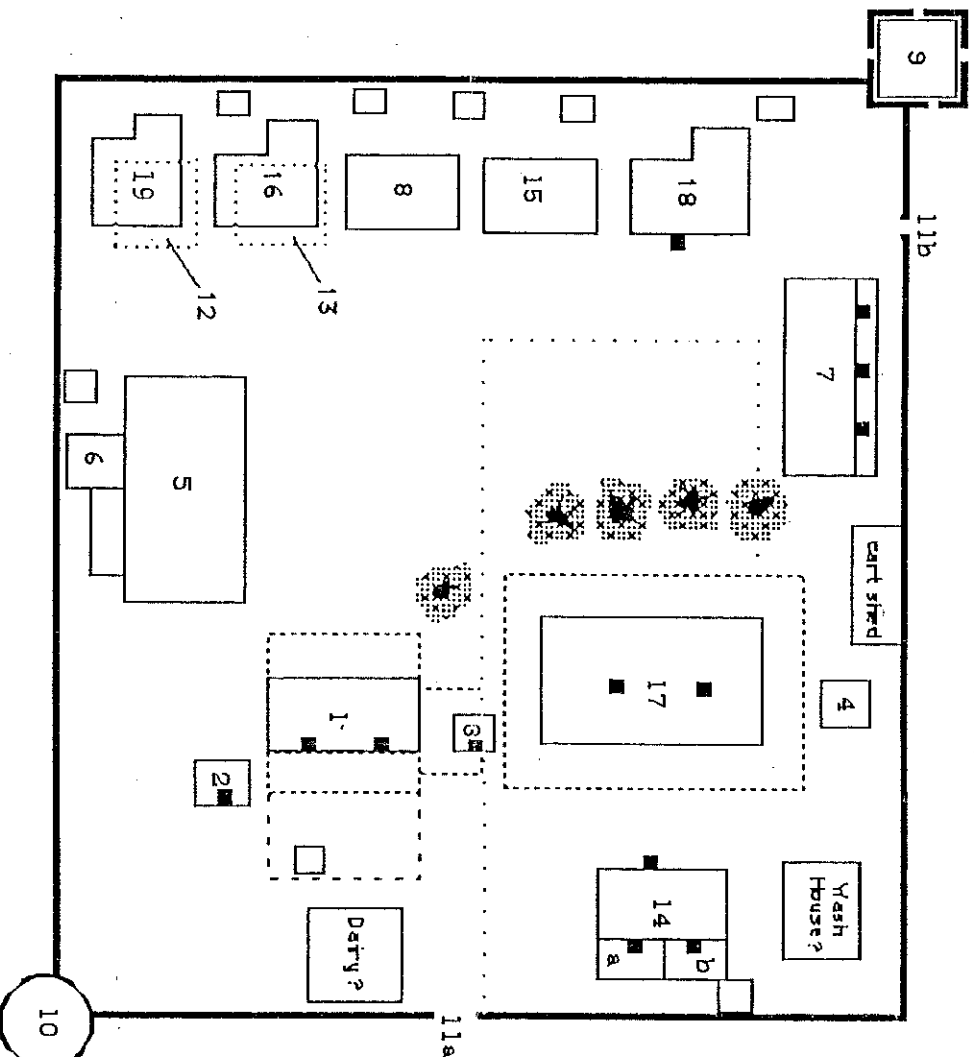
